this internal critique of zionism challenges three notions that the jews are a nation that exile is the main cause of their past suffering and that jewish history is made solely in israel zionism is an illusion because it has failed to normalize the jewish condition in particular it has not eliminated anti semitism but rather cultivates it in order to keep jews within the fold once independent the state of israel emptied the middle east and north africa of their jewish populations and prevented large numbers of soviet jews from settling in north america or anywhere else but israel now the target is france but french jews though massively zionist are reluctant to emigrate israel it seems cannot thrive and prosper without draining the diaspora of its finances its youth indeed its very identity israeli control of jerusalem has not brought the messianic age any closer rabbis used to worry that the holocaust could mean that god abrogated his covenant with the jews israel s victory in 1967 convinced them that the covenant still holds the holocaust has however encouraged jewish paganism as jews adulate power and define themselves purely as an ethnic group hitlerjuden the state of israel claims to be the culmination of jewish history but its leaders insist that we are still in the rut of 1938 the state of israel is perfectly capable of defending itself and has no need of solidarity rallies in the diaspora zionism allows the jewish establishment to retain power but reduces the diaspora to a subordinate role yet judaism was born and developed in exile if jews divest themselves of their siege mentality judaism can become a university for adults without examinations or tuition fees open to all

in the wake of the establishment of the state of israel in 1948 it has often been alleged

king abdullah i of jordan and the zionist movements colluded to partition mandate palestine between them while great britain the retreating imperial power gave them tacit approval to do so here tancred bradshaw challenges these allegations looking at the complex and often strained relations between the emerging states of jordan israel and the at first hegemonic and then crumbling british empire using a wide range of primary sources which have previously been largely ignored britain and jordan offers an essential re examination of the relationships which were to shape the middle east as it is today it thus contains vital analysis for anyone involved in the study of the middle east its politics and history as well as the demise of britain s empire in the region

a companion to world war ii brings together a series of fresh academic perspectives on world war ii exploring the many cultural social and political contexts of the war essay topics range from american anti semitism to the experiences of french african soldiers providing nearly 60 new contributions to the genre arranged across two comprehensive volumes a collection of original historiographic essays that include cutting edge research analyzes the roles of neutral nations during the war examines the war from the bottom up through the experiences of different social classes covers the causes key battles and consequences of the war

genocide ethnonationalism and the united nations examines a series of related crises in human civilization growing out of conflicts between powerful states or empires and indigenous or stateless peoples this is the first book to attempt to explore the causes of genocide and other mass killing by a detailed exploration of un archives covering the period spanning from 1945 through 2011 hannibal travis argues that large states and empires disproportionately committed or facilitated genocide and other mass killings between 1945 and 2011 his research incorporates data concerning factors linked to the scale of mass killing and recent findings in human rights political science and legal theory turning to potential solutions he argues that the concept of genocide imagines a future system of global governance under which the nation state itself is made subject to law the united nations however has deflected the possibility of such a cosmopolitical law it selectively condemns genocide and has established an institutional structure that denies most peoples subjected to genocide of a realistic possibility of global justice lacks a robust international criminal tribunal or un army and even encourages security

cooperation among states that have proven to be destructive of peoples in the past questions raised include what have been the causes of mass killing during the period since the united nations charter entered into force in 1945 how does mass killing spread across international borders and what is the role of resource wealth the arms trade and external interference in this process have the united nations or the international criminal court faced up to the problem of genocide and other forms of mass killing as is their mandate

from serving as the middle east correspondent for the new yorker to penning articles for the new york times milton viorst has dedicated his career to studying the middle east now in this new book viorst examines the evolution of zionism from its roots by serving as a cultural refuge for europe s jews to the cover it provides today for israel s exercise of control over millions of arabs in occupied territories beginning with the shattering of the traditional jewish society during the enlightenment viorst covers the recent history of the jews from the spread of jewish emancipation during the french revolution era to the rise of the exclusionary anti semitism that overwhelmed europe in the late nineteenth century viorst examines how zionism was born and follows its development through the lives and ideas of its dominant leaders who all held only one tenet in common that jews for the first time in two millennia must determine their own destiny to save themselves but in regards to creating a jewish state with a military that dominates the region viorst argues that israel has squandered the goodwill it enjoyed at its founding and thus the country has put its own future on very uncertain footing with the expertise and knowledge garnered from decades of studying this contentious region milton viorst deftly exposes the risks that israel faces today
